Acceptable Obedience

- Some obedience is not acceptable. Isaiah 1:11ff
 - Sacrifices, feasts, prayers. (cf. Malachi 1:6-10)
- Warned of disobedience. Deuteronomy 4, 8.28-30
- > Purpose of man. Ecclesiastes 12:13-14
- Change necessary to acceptable obedience. Romans 6:16-18
- > Not simply a matter of performing the act. Revelation 22:14

Things Necessary To Acceptable Obedience

Submissive Obedience.

(hupotasso) "primarily a military term, to rank under" (W.E. Vine)

- "to arrange under, to subordinate; to subject, put in subjection" (Thayer)
- Wives and children. Colossians 3:18; Ephesians 5:22ff; cf. 1 Peter 3:1ff; Ephesians 6:1

"Subjecting yourselves one to another in the fear of Christ." Ephesians 5:21

Things Necessary To Acceptable Obedience

Submissive Obedience.

- > Because God said so!
- > Jesus came to do the will of the Father. John 6:38; Philippians 2:5-8
- > Submitting to authority. Luke 7:1ff
- > Our aim. 2 Corinthians 5:9-10
- Not everyone is pleasing to Him.
 1 Thessalonians 2:15; 2 Corinthians 10:18
- > Try to learn how to please God. Ephesians 5:10
- Please Him in all things. Colossians 1:9-10

Things Necessary To Acceptable Obedience

Obedience Of Faith. Romans 1:5; 16:26

- > Outgrowth of faith. Hebrews 11
- > Faith comes by hearing. Romans
- > Obedience necessary. James 2:22ff

Things Necessary To Acceptable Obedience

Prompt Obedience.

- > Today! 2 Corinthians 6:2
- > Abraham arose early. Genesis 22:18ff
- > Israel failed. Deuteronomy 1:41-45
- Examples of conversion. Acts 2:41; 8:36ff; 16:30ff

Procrastination robs.

- > Children, grandchildren.
- > Felix. Acts 24

Loving Obedience.

John 14:15, "If ye love me, ye will keep my commandments." ASV John 14:15, "If ye love me, keep my commandments." KJV (cf. John 14:21,23-24)

Loving Obedience.

1 John 5:3-5, "For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous. For whatsoever is begotten of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that hath overcome the world, (even) our faith.
