- "Renunciation of a religious faith"
- "Abandonment of a previous loyalty: Defection"
 - Source: Merriam Webster's on-line dictionary
- The word *apostasy* not found in the Bible, but the principle and possibility is
- Many religious people have been taught and persuaded that it is <u>impossible</u> for a Christian to sin so as to loose their salvation
- We will examine this claim with plain Bible evidence

The Hiscox Standard Baptist Manual

"We believe the Scriptures teach that such as are truly regenerate, being born of the Spirit, will not utterly fall away and finally perish, but will endure unto the end; that their preserving attachment to Christ is the grand mark which distinguishes them from superficial professors; that a special providence watches over their welfare; and they are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation."

"We take the position that a Christian's sins do not damn his soul. The way a Christian lives, what he says, his character, his conduct, or his attitude toward other people have nothing whatever to do with the salvation of his soul... All the prayers a man may pray, all the Bibles he may read, all the churches he may belong to, all the services he may attend, all the sermons he may practice, all the debts he may pay, all the ordinances he may observe, all the debts he may keep, all the benevolent acts he may perform will not make his soul one whit safer; and all the sins he may commit from idolatry to murder will not make his soul in any more danger ... The way a man lives has nothing whatever to do with the salvation of his soul ... The way I live has nothing whatsoever to do with the salvation of my soul." Bible Defeats Calvin<u>ism</u>

- <u>Calvinism</u>: the theological system of (John) <u>Calvin</u> and his followers marked by strong emphasis on the sovereignty of God, the depravity of humankind, and the doctrine of predestination.
- **TULIP** Doctrine:
 - Total Depravity All babies are born into the world destined for hell. Inherit the sin of Adam.
 - **Unconditional Election** God had a predetermined master list of the saved before creation. This list cannot be changed.
 - Limited Atonement Christ did not die for all men on the "saved list."
 - Irresistible Grace God sends the Holy Spirit only to those on the "sayed list."

 Perseverance (preserving) of the Saints – A child of God once saved, cannot be lost.



What do the Scriptures say?

"The Scriptures teach that a child of God, one saved by the blood of Christ, <u>can</u> so sin as to be lost eternally in hell"

1 Peter 5:8

"Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, walks about as a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour"

1 Corinthians 10:8-12



Question: How can one fall from a position he has never been in? This statement implies that he was formerly <u>in</u> the grace of Christ.

The Possibility of Apostasy

The Bible teaches that the righteous can turn to unrighteousness and die!

"But when a righteous man turns away from his righteousness and commits iniquity, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked man does, shall he live? All the righteousness which he has done shall not be remembered; because of the unfaithfulness of which he is guilty and the sin which he has committed, because of them he shall die"– Ezekiel 18:20-24 NKJV

The Possibility of Apostasy

The Bible teaches that one who has believed can fall away!

"But the ones on the rock are those who, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, who believe for a while and in time of temptation fall away" – Luke 8:13 NKJV

The Possibility of Apostasy

 The Bible of turn away in feeling or severed affection; make unfriendly or hostile; alienate the rom grace!

"Indeed I, Paul, say to you that if you become circumcised, Christ will profit you nothing. And I testify again to every man who becomes circumcised that he is a debtor to keep the whole law. You have become estranged from Christ, you who attempt to be justified by law; you have fallen from grace"– Galatians 5:2-4 NKJV; cf. 1:6-9



The Possibility of Apostasy

• The Bible teaches that one can be cut off from the vine (Christ) and wither!

"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. 6 "If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is <u>withered</u>; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned." John 15:5-6

The Possibility of Apostasy

The Bible teaches that those once enlightened can fall away and be beyond renewal.

"For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit, and have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the age to come, if they fall away, to renew them again to repentance, since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame" – Hebrews 6:4-6 NKJV

The Possibility of Apostasy

Other things a Child of God can do:

- "Err from the truth" James 5:19
- "Cast off their first faith" and "turned aside after Satan"- 1 Timothy 5:12-15
- "Fall into condemnation" James 5:12
- Be "moved away from the hope of the gospel" Colossians 1:23
- Believe the gospel "in vain" 1 Corinthians 15:1-2
- Become "worse than an infidel" 1 Timothy 5:8
- Be spewed out of the Lord's mouth Revelation 3:16
- "Draw back to perdition (destruction)" Hebrews 10:39
- "Fall short of the grace of God" Hebrews 12:15

God's Remedy For Apostasy

- Repent of your sins!
 - Acts 8:22
- Confess your sins to God and your brethren!
 1 John 1:9; James 5:16
- Pray to God for His forgiveness!
 Acts 8:22
- Be <u>TRULY</u> converted!
 - Romans 6:5-11
