- Neither will deny the other normal sexual pleasure. 1 Corinthians 7:3-5; Hebrews 13:4
- Each provides emotional security for the other. Colossians 3:19; Titus 2:3-4
- > Parenthood is made a reality where it is possible. Psalms 127:3-5
- Both partners make wise and unselfish use of their resources. Proverbs 31:13-34; 1 Timothy 5:8; 2 Thessalonians 3:10-11
