Humility Before The Lord Is Manifested

1. Be Careful What You Say.

"Speak not one against another..." James 4:11-12

- Matthew 7:1-2; John 7:24
- DO NOT become judges of the law!
 - The law says, "Love your neighbor" Leviticus 19:18; cf. James 2:8

General Applications:

One's thoughts should pass three gates before they are spoken.

IS IT TRUE?

"Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor" (Exodus 20:16).

- God hates "... a lying tongue" (Proverbs 6:17).
- "lie not one to another seeing that ye have put off the old man with his doings" (Colossians 3:9).
- "... all liars, their part shall be in the lake that burneth with fire and brimstone ..." (Revelation 21:8).

General Applications:

One's thoughts should pass three gates before they are spoken.

IS IT NEEDFUL?

- "... a talebearer revealeth secrets" (Proverbs 11:13).
- "... he that repeateth a matter separateth very friends" (KJV Proverbs 17:9).
- "Thou shalt not go up and down as a talebearer among thy people ..." (Leviticus 19:16).

Avoid arrogance and self-sufficiency. James 4:13-17

"What is your life? For ye are a vapor, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away."

Life is brief.

Psalms 90:10, "The days of our years are three score and ten, or even by reason of strength fourscore years: yet is their pride but labor and sorrows, for it is soon gone, and we fly away." Verse 12, "Teach us to number our days that we may get us a heart of wisdom."

Humility Before The Lord Is Manifested

Avoid arogance and self-sufficiency. James 4:13-17

"What is your life? For ye are a vapor, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away."

Death is certain.

Ecclesiastes 9:5, "For the living know they shall die." Hebrews 9:27, "It is appointed unto men once to die."

Sin defined:

James 4:17, "To him therefore that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin."

Humility Before The Lord Is Manifested

3. Right attitude toward riches. James 5:1-6

These brethren (James 2:1, 14; 3:1) had:

- Hoarded wealth. James 5:2-3; 1 Timothy 6:6ff; Matthew 6:19
- Held back wages due laborers. James 5:4 (cf. Leviticus 19:13; Jeremiah 22:13; Malachi 3:5)
- Lived in self-indulgence. James 5:5 (Luke 12:15-21; cf. Amos 6)
- Murdered innocent men. James 5:6

Humility Before The Lord Is Manifested

4. Patience. James 5:7-11

makrothuméœ – "to endure patiently as opposed to losing faith or giving up (Heb 6:15; James 5:7,8)" (Complete Word Study Dictionary)

Illustrations:

- Farmer must wait for the harvest. James 5:7
- Prophets endured suffering. James 5:7; cf. Galatians 6:9

hupomonee, "in the N.T. the characteristic of a man who is unswerved from his deliberate purpose and his loyalty to faith and piety by even the greatest trials and sufferings." (Thayer)

Illustration:

• Job persevered. James 5:11 (cf. Hebrews 10:36)
