I Have The Right To Be Happy!

"We hold these truths to be self-evident: that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are **life**, **liberty**, **and the pursuit of**

happiness." (Thomas Jefferson, Declaration of Independence, July 4, 1776)

The phrase gives three examples of the **"unalienable rights"** which the Declaration says have been given to all human beings by their Creator, and which governments are created to protect.

- Society ...
 - Walk away from marriage. Malachi2:14
 - Sinful activities. Genesis 6;1 Corinthians 6
 - Happiness is the most important goal in life.

I Have The Right To Be Happy!

- > A refusal to take life seriously (We only live once so live it up, have fun! "Get all the gusto you can!")
- ►<u>The use/abuse of intoxicants</u> (alcohol, drugs, trying to cope)!
- > Materialism bigger is better, more is best! (cf. Don Snider, not happier with more!)
- Entertainment (Camping out to buy tickets to see ______. Church programs)!

I Have The Right To Be Happy!

- > Sports Involvement (Pay to play, almost a religion taking precedence)!
- ➤ Sensuality (LGBT, nudity, sex, pornography)!
- > <u>Self-esteem</u> (No one loses, everyone gets a trophy, no valedictorian)!

- 3. Tells Us To Get <u>Serious</u>. (verse 4) Grow up! cf. 1 Corinthians 13; cf. Luke 12:20; READ Ecclesiastes 8:8; 7:6
- 4. Affirms That We **Too** Are <u>Mortal</u>. (verse 1) James 1:2-3
 - Many unprepared for life / death. Luke 6:25
