2. All were under law to God

- Otherwise, they could not have been counted wicked (Romans 5:13).
- What makes man wicked/sinful is his transgression of divine law (1 John 3:4).
- All mankind is accountable to Him.

Many were wicked and few were righteous 3. God views humanity with regard to our relationship with him • He observed most of mankind as wicked in Noah's day. "... Every intent of the thoughts of the heart was only evil

- Every intent of the thoughts of the heart was only evil continually" (Genesis 6:5)
- On the other hand, "Noah found favor in the eyes of Jehovah" (verse 8; 2 Peter 2:5). Noah "walked with God" (Genesis 6:9)
- God desperately wants a relationship with us (2 Peter 3:9; 1 Timothy 2:4), but that is up to us. God has done everything He can do! Isaiah 5:1-4
- Unfortunately, most will choose to not walk with God. Matthew 7:13-14

God Gave Warnings

- God (repeatedly) warned of the unseen.
 Hebrews 11:7 (11:1); 2 Corinthians 4:16-18; 5:7
- God's warnings are for our good (Deuteronomy 6:4), that we should escape the sorrow that sin causes now and in eternity (Hebrews 12:25; Galatians 6:7-8; 2 Thessalonians 1:8-9; Revelation 21:8).
- ► God uses mankind to convey His warnings: 2 Peter 2:5; Ezekiel 33:1-9

God Gave Warnings

God's warnings to us:

- ▶ Whom to fear (Satan and false teachers): Luke 12:5; Matthew 16:6, 12
- ▶ What to fear (greed/covetousness): Luke 12:15
- When to fear (when you stand): 1 Corinthians 10:12
- Why to fear (eternal punishment): 2 Thessalonians 1:8-9

God Was Patient/ Long Suffering

- ► God gave man time to repent. 1 Peter 3:20; Genesis 6:3
- ► God is also giving us time to repent. 2 Peter 3:9-15; Romans 2:4
- Just as in the days of Noah, once again, God's patience will end. Luke 13:25; Exodus 34:6-7

Few Were Saved

- 1 Peter 3:20, "... few ... were brought safely through the water ..." Few today are brought safely through the water also.
- Matthew 22:14, "For many are called, but few are chosen." Matthew 7:13-14; Luke 13:23-24.
- ▶ Will we continue to submit? Jeremiah 42:1-3
- Don't be discouraged and get to work. 1 Kings 19:9-10; 18
