



"IN THE NAME OF ..." | Colossians 3:17




Name (onoma) – used for everything the name covers [rank, authority, command, deeds, etc.]
 Lord (kurios) - he to whom a person or thing belongs, about which he has power of deciding

Definitions | Thayer




(3:17), Do it all because he requires and commands it, and with a desire to honor him. His authority should be the warrant; his glory the aim of all our actions and words.
