Judging Righteous Judgment We must reprove sin ... 2 Timothy 4:2-4; Titus 1:9-14; Luke 17:3; cf. Matthew 18:15; James 5:19-20; Ezekiel 33:1-9; Ephesians 5:11; Proverbs 28:4; 24:2425; Galatians 6:1 WHY? Because of our love for the lost! Matthew 22:39; Ephesians 4:15; cf. Proverbs 27:5-6

What Does It Mean To Preach The Gospel? Preach man's need for salvation. Ephesians 1:7; Matthew 1:21; Romans 3:23 Preach man's need to repent. Luke 24:47; Luke 13:3; 2 Peter 3:9; Acts 17:30-31

Judging Righteous Judgment John 7:24 Have others really violated God's word? John 7:22-23 "Not according to appearance." Matthew 15:1-14 Traditions 1 Corinthians 1:18-25; 2:2-5 Human wisdom Standard is God's word. John 12:48; cf. Jude 3; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 John 9 We are not lawmakers. Galatians 1:8-9 Not to judge by opinions or personal preferences. Romans 14:1-4, 10-13; cf. Proverbs 17:15

Judging Righteous Judgment John 7:24

- Am I speaking from proper motives?
- Meekness. 1 Peter 3:15; 2 Timothy 2:24-26; Galatians 6:1ff

Wrong motives ...

- Pride or personal gain. 1 Timothy 6:3-5
- Jealousy. James 3:14-18
- Vengeance. Romans 12:17-21
- Anger. James 1:19-20; Ephesians 4:26

Some Will Reject Rebuke

Sodomites threatened Lot. Gen. 19:7,9
Israelites wanted to stone Joshua and Caleb. Numbers 14:1-10
Jeroboam sought to arrest the young prophet. 1 Kings 13:1-5
Jezebel threatened to kill Elijah.
1 Kings 19:1-2
Herod imprisoned and killed John.

Some Will Reject Rebuke

- World hated Jesus. John 7:7
- Jewish council beat the apostles.
 Acts 5:27-32; 40-42
- Jewish council stopped their ears and stoned Stephen. Acts 7:51-58
- Jews tried to kill Paul, Acts 9:29
- Judaizing teachers considered Paul an enemy. Galatians 4:16

Some Do Not Want To Be Rebuked – John 3:19-21
