Noah lived in a wicked world. Genesis 6:5-7

- Wicked in the first century Romans 1:18ff; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11; Galatians 5:19ff; Ephesians 4-5; Colossians 3; 1 & 2 Thessalonians
 Reports of historians
 - Reports of historians.
- We also live in a wicked world, under the promise of destruction. 2 Peter 3:10

Noah – A Preacher Of Righteousness

Noah lived a distinctive life. Genesis 6:8– 9, "But Noah found favor in the eyes of Jehovah. These are the generations of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, (and) perfect in his generations: Noah walked with God."

• We also must be different. Matthew 5:13– 16; Romans 12:2; Philippians 2:12; Ephesians 5:8–11; 1 Peter 4:1–4

Noah – A Preacher Of Righteousness

Noah preached righteousness.

- 2 Peter 2:5, God ... "spared not the ancient world, but preserved Noah with seven others, a preacher of righteousness, when he brought a flood upon the world of the ungodly"
- Preached and believed revelation, not human reason. Hebrews 11:7; 1 Corinthians 2:14-16 (1:18, 23-24)
- Noah practiced what he preached. Ezekiel 14:14, 20
- We also must preach righteousness. Romans 1:16; Ephesians 3:8; 1 Timothy 1:11-12; 4:16;
- 1 Corinthians 9:14–18

Noah – A Preacher Of Righteousness

Noah had a working faith.

- Hebrews 11:7, "By faith Noah, being warned (of God) concerning things not seen as yet, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; through which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith."
- Noah saw the unseen. Hebrews 11:1; Colossians 1:5.
- Judgment is coming. cf. Acts 24:24–25.
- Reward of the righteous. Acts 10:35; Romans 2:7, 10.
- We also must work with a view to judgment. cf. James 2:14ff; 2 Peter 3

Noah – A Preacher Of Righteousness

Noah worked while God waited. Genesis 6:22: 7:5. cf. 1 Peter 3:20

We must work, while God waits.

- 2 Peter 3:9; 1 Corinthians 15:58;
- 1 Thessalonians 3:12-13

Noah – A Preacher Of Righteousness

Noah and his family were saved! • We too, can be saved!

1 Peter 3:20–21, "... that aforetime were disobedient, when the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water: which also after a true likeness doth now save you, (even) baptism, not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the interrogation of a good conscience toward God, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ"
