Who is he?

The Devil – Revelation 12:9

"Diablos" – means slanderer or false accuser.

Who does he accuse?

Man before God –

Job 1:9-12, "put forth Thy hand now and touch all that he has; he will surely curse Thee to Thy face".

"the accuser of our brethren" Rev. 12:10

The Devil – Revelation 12:9

Who does he accuse?

God before man.
