Rejection Of Divine Authority-No Love For The Truth

2 Thessalonians 2:10–12 "and with all deceit of unrighteousness for them that perish; because they received <u>not the love of the</u> <u>truth</u>, that they might be saved. And for this cause God sendeth them a working of error, that they should believe a lie: that they all might be judged who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness."

Rejection Of Divine Authority-No Love For The Truth

- "Prophesy not unto us right things, speak unto us smooth things, prophesy deceits" (Isaiah 30:10)
- "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied." (Matthew 5:6; Note 1 Peter 2:1)
- Revealed in the GOSPEL is God's plan to make man righteous. Romans 1:16-17; cf. Proverbs 23:23

Rejection Of Divine Authority-No Love For The Truth

- > <u>What will the next generation be</u>? Judges 2:10
- Fear of losing our young people turns the church into a social club.

Rejection Of Divine Authority-No Love For The Truth

- Conversion The result of teaching.
 If viewed the people from spiritual condition. (Ephesians 2:1-2)
- If view them without hope. (Ephesians 2:12)
 Faithfulness The result of teaching. (cf. Titus 2:11-14; 1 Corinthians 15:58;
- (cf. Titus 2:11–14; 1 Corinthians 15:58; Revelation 2:10)

Rejection Of Divine Authority-No Respect For The Sacred Sacred - "to be devoutly revered." (Thayer) 2 Timothy 3:15 "And that from a babe thou hast known the <u>sacred</u> writings which are

able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus."

Rejection Of Divine Authority-No Respect For The Sacred

Illustrations of the Sacred.

- > Sabbath day. (Exodus 20:8; cf. Numbers 15:32-36)
- Moses drew near the burning bush in the wilderness, God said,
 "Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from
- off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground" (Exodus 3:5)
- Nadab and Abihu. "I will be sanctified in them that come nigh me, and before all the people will be glorified" (Leviticus 10:3).

Rejection Of Divine Authority-No Respect For The Sacred

Illustrations of the Sacred.

- > Jews in Nehemiah's day, when the law was read. (Nehemiah 8:5)
- "Let us have grace, whereby we may offer service well-pleasing to God with reverence and awe: for our God is a consuming fire" (Hebrews 12:28-29).
- > NOTE: To treat what is holy, "sacred" as if it were common profanes it.

Rejection Of Divine Authority-Nothing Distinctive

Distinctions in Scripture. 1 Peter 2:9

- > Wide way from the narrow way. (Matthew 7:13-14)
- > Wise from the foolish. (Matthew 7:24-27)
- Kingdom of darkness from the Kingdom of Christ. (Colossians 1:13-14)

Rejection Of Divine Authority-Nothing Distinctive

Distinctions In Scripture.

- > One way from all others. (John 14:6)
- > The gospel from all others. (Galatians 1:6-9)
- > One body from all others. (Ephesians 1:22–23; 4:4)
- > One baptism from all others. (Ephesians 4:5)
- > Truth and error. (Ephesians 4:14-15)

Rejection Of Divine Authority-Nothing Distinctive

 We cannot blend God's way with man's way. (Proverbs 14:12)
 Desire of the people for a king. (1 Samuel 8; Deuteronomy 17)
 Peter's desire to build three tabernacles. (Matthew 17:1-5)

Rejection Of Divine Authority-No Confrontation

- > Immodest attire, filthy language, fornication, adultery, homosexuality ...
- > Must preach the whole counsel of God. (Acts 20:27)

Rejection Of Divine Authority-No Confrontation

God Despises Sin

Proverbs 15:9 "The way of the wicked is an abomination to Jehovah" Proverbs 28:9 "He that turneth away his ear from hearing the law, Even his prayer is an

abomination."

Rejection Of Divine Authority-No Confrontation

The Gospel Is Confrontational

- > Evangelism is not possible without confrontation.
- (cf. Acts 2:36; 3:12–15; 4:8–10)
- > Repentance commanded. (Acts 17:30-31) > All are accountable!
- Paul called on churches to put to death the deeds of the body. (Colossians 3:5-11)
