What is the Language of Ashdod?

- Neh. 13:23-24 "In those days I also saw Jews who had married women of Ashdod, Ammon, and Moab. And half of their children spoke the language of Ashdod, and could not speak the language of Judah, but spoke according to the language of one or the other people."
- History of trouble from mixed marriages
 - Jdg. 1:27-3:6, **3:6-7**; Neh. 13:25-28
 - The Children of Israel could not understand or express the law of Moses Neh. 8:2,5,8

- Language is the mode of communication
- Words are signs and ideas
- Bible words express God's ideas
 2 Peter 1:20-21; 1 Cor. 2:12-13
- The words of Jesus sound, wholesome words
 - Mt. 7:29; Col. 3:16-17; 1 Tim. 6:3-5
- "Hold fast" and stick to the pattern
 2 Tim. 1:13-14; Heb. 8:5

What is the Language of Ashdod?

- Not clearly knowing God is the greatest of Losses!

- Forsook God's ideas (words) and took up the ideas of idolatry. Judges 3:6-7
