The Mistakes Of Eli Deut. 6:4-9: Ex. 12:25-28: Josh. 4:19-24

Eli - Did not teach his children!

1 Sam 3:13 "For I have told him that I will judge his house for ever, for the iniquity which he knew, because his sons did bring a curse upon themselves, and he restrained them not."

The Mistakes Of Eli

WHO WAS ELI?

- ➤ He was a descendant of Ithamar, the youngest son of Aaron.
- ➤ He held the office of high priest, and helped to raise Samuel.
- ➤ He became judge at age 58, and judged Israel for 40 years. cf. 1 Sam. 4:15, 18 (98 when he died)

The Mistakes Of Eli

WHO WAS ELI?

- ➤ When first mentioned, he must have been around 70 years old.
- His sons were children of his old age, for sometimes afterward they were spoken of as young men. cf. 1 Sam. 2:17

The Mistakes Of Eli

ELI WILL ALWAYS BE KNOWN AS MAN WHO DID NOT RESTRAIN HIS SONS...

- ➤ His sons Hophni and Phineas were corrupt, and did not know the Lord. – 1 Sam. 2:12-17
- ➤ He sought to reprove his sons, he knew what they did; but it was ineffective. - 1Sam. 2:22-25
- ➤ Therefore God sent a man of God to pronounce judgment on his household. -1 Sam. 2:27-36
- ➤ The Lord also told Samuel of the reason for such judgment. -1 Sam. 3:10-14

The Mistakes Of Eli

HIS CORRECTION WAS NOT ADMINISTERED IN PROPER TIME

- His sons' insistence to sin must have been seen long before the rumor of their flagrant transgressions reached him. 1 Sam. 2:24
- ➤ It was evident his sons did not know the Lord, yet they had been appointed priests.

The Mistakes Of Eli

- ➤ Eli, being old and weak, TOO gentle and easy going temperament.
- > Thus he failed to reprove them until they were too devoted to their evil ways.
- ➤ In this Eli was like David in his old age and his son Adonijah - cf. 1 Kings 1:5-6

The Mistakes Of Eli

HIS REBUKE WAS NOT GIVEN WITH SUFFICIENT EARNESTNESS

- ➤ It was not sufficiently pointed in its application.
 - Given to them collectively rather than individually.
 - By way of question, rather than a direct charge.1 Sam. 2:23
 - Concerning things he had heard, but had not troubled himself to find out for certain.

The Mistakes Of Eli

HIS REBUKE EXHIBITED NO SUFFICIENT SENSE OF THE EVIL OF SIN

- > He spoke of the consequences of sin rather than the nature of sin.
- ➤ He seemed more concerned about the reputation than the sin itself. 1 Sam. 2:23-24

The Mistakes Of Eli

HIS REBUKE SHOWED INSUFFICIENT DETERMINATION TO CORRECT THE SIN

- > He did not threaten to judge them for their injustice toward men.
- ➤ He simply left them to the judgment of God.
 - 1 Sam. 2:25

The Mistakes Of Eli

HIS REBUKE WAS NOT FOLLOWED BY ADEQUATE CHASTISEMENT

- ➤ The law of Moses in the case of disobedient children was very severe. Deut 21:18-21
- ▶ But Eli did not observe this law "when they hearkened not unto the voice of their father."
 1 Sam. 2:25

The Mistakes Of Eli

- ➤ Nor did he take any further steps to prevent the continuance of the evil which he reproved.
- But as a father, a high priest, and a judge he was guilty of willful disobedience. - cf. 1Sam. 3:12-13

The Mistakes Of Eli

HIS REBUKE DID NOT RESULT IN ANY IMPROVEMENT

Their contempt of reproof revealed that they were already infatuated and hardened.

- ➤ God had already given them up to destruction. -1 Sam. 2:25
- ➤ In them the proverb was to be fulfilled: "He that hateth reproof shall die" Prov. 15:10

The Mistakes Of Eli Lessons Learned

- 1. The tendency to go wrong appears at an early age.
- 2. Hard to move a grown tree. cf. Prov. 19:18
- 3. Some children can be "discouraged" by too much strictness. cf. Col. 3:21
- 4. Yet far more are spoiled by too much indulgence. "Can't buy love or respect."

The Mistakes Of Eli Lessons Learned

- 1. To make sure our reproofs sufficiently pointed. ("Thou art the man!") cf. 2 Sam. 12:7
- 2. To communicate the exceedingly sinfulness of sin
- 3. To make every effort within our power to stop the sinning being done

The Mistakes Of Eli Lessons Learned

- 1. Fathers who love their children chastise them appropriately. cf. Heb. 12:6-8
- 2. Fathers in a position to restrain their children's sinful behavior, have the duty to do so!
- 3. Whether it be in the home, in the church, or in the community.

The Mistakes Of Eli Lessons Learned

- 1. If we wait too long to reprove, it may be too late. Prov. 19:18
- 2. It is possible for one to become hardened by sin Rom. 2:4-5; Heb. 3:12-13
- 3. One can reach a point where it becomes impossible for us to restore them again to repentance Heb. 6:4-6

The Mistakes Of Eli

- > HOW MUCH BETTER, TO RECEIVE CORRECTION BEFORE ITS TOO LATE! cf. Prov. 1:23
- > HOW SAD, THAT ELI COULD ACCEPT REPROOF, BUT NOT GIVE IT AS ONE SHOULD...!

Prov. 13:25 "He that spareth his rod hateth his son; But he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes."

The Mistakes Of Eli Conclusion

- 1. REPROOF IS A SOLEMN OBLIGATION...
- a. It should be given in an effective manner
- b. When not so given it can do more harm than good
- 2. REPROOF SHOULD BE HUMBLY AND OBEDIENTLY RECEIVED...
- a. As Eli did, when he accepted the Lord's judgment cf. 1Sam, 3:15-18
