Acts 19

Trying work. (verses 8-9; 23-31; 2 Corinthians 1:8ff) Lengthy. (verse 10) Rewarding. (verse 10)

Acts 20:36-38 Affectionate.

Ephesians 3:8

- Three Things:
 - What Paul says about HIMSELF.
 - What Paul says about HIS WORK.
 - What Paul says about the great SUBJECT of his preaching.

What Paul Says About HIMSELF Ephesians 3:8 "<u>Unto me, who am less than the least</u> of all saints."

- Paul was a persecutor:
 Acts 8:1 Held the garments of those who stoned Stephen. cf. Acts 22:19-22
 - Acts 8:3 Laid waste the church.
 - Acts 9:1 Breathed threatening and slaughter.
 - 1 Timothy 1:12-15 Considered himself chief of sinners.
 - 1 Corinthians 15:9-10 Least of the apostles.
 - Acts 26:9ff Punished the disciples.

What Paul Says About HIMSELF Ephesians 3:8

"<u>Was this grace given</u> ..." Verses 2,7-8

- 1 Corinthians 9:17 "I have a stewardship intrusted to me."
- 1 Timothy 1:11 "gospel of the blessed God, which was committed to my trust."
- "to make all men see …" Ephesians 3:9
- "to present every man perfect ..." Colossians 1:24-29
- "Necessity is laid upon me; for woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel." 1 Corinthians 9:16

What Paul Says About His WORK Ephesians 3:8

"To preach unto the Gentiles."

- Paul preached unto the Jews. Acts 13:14ff; 17:1-2
- He turned unto the Gentiles. Acts 13:46-48
- Apostle unto the Gentiles. Acts 9:15; 22:21; 26:16-23

What Paul Says About His WORK Ephesians 3:8

- "To preach unto the <u>Gentiles</u>." (note: Ephesians 1:3ff "us" & "ye")
- What an honor.
- What a responsibility.
 - Must preach it right. 2 Timothy 4:2-4
 - Must preach it in its fullness. Acts 20:26-27
 - No more, no less. Galatians 1:6
 - Jeopardize our soul and those who hear. 1 Timothy 4:16; cf. James 3:1

What Paul Says About The SUBJECT Of His Preaching. Ephesians 3:8

- "The unsearchable riches of Christ."
- Definition: (Greek anexichniastos) "not tracked out, i.e. (by implication) untraceable" (Strong's)

What Paul Says About The SUBJECT Of His Preaching. Ephesians 3:8

"The unsearchable riches of Christ."

- Job 5:8-9 "But as for me, I would seek unto God, And unto God would I commit my cause; Who doeth great things and <u>unsearchable</u>, Marvellous things without number."
- Psalms 145:3 "Great is Jehovah, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness is <u>unsearchable</u>."

What Paul Says About The SUBJECT Of His Preaching. Ephesians 3:8

- Romans 11:33 "O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and the knowledge of God! how <u>unsearchable</u> are his judgments, and his ways past tracing out! For who hath known the mind of the Lord? Or who hath been his counsellor?"
- Note: Isaiah 55:8-9

What Paul Says About The SUBJECT Of His Preaching. Ephesians 3:8 _____

It was a mystery.

- Ephesians 1:9 "make known unto us the <u>mystery</u> of His will."
- Ephesians 3:3 "Was made known unto me the <u>mystery</u> ..."
- Ephesians 3:4 *"… my understanding in the <u>mystery</u> …"*_____

What Paul Says About The SUBJECT Of His Preaching. Ephesians 3:8

It was a mystery.

- Ephesians 3:9 To make all men see the *"dispensation of the <u>mystery</u>."*
- *Ephesians 6:19 "the <u>mystery</u> of the gospel"* points to God's plan of redeeming man from sin and death.

What Paul Says About The SUBJECT Of His Preaching. Ephesians 3:8 Definition: *"mystery." (Greek musterion)*

- "a hidden purpose or counsel; secret will: of men ... In the N.T., God's plan of providing salvation for men through Christ, which was once hidden but now is revealed: Romans 16:25; 1 Corinthians 2:7; Ephesians 3:9; Col 1:26" (Thayer)
- "... may be best illustrated by the following passage: 'the mystery which hath been hid from all ages and generations: but now hath it been manifested to His saints'' Colossians 1:26 (Vine)

What Paul Says About The SUBJECT Of His Preaching. Ephesians 3:8

- <u>God's redemptive plan was hidden, now been</u> <u>revealed</u>.
- Previous generations did not know. Ephesians 3:3-5, 9
- Prophets & angels did not know. 1 Peter 1:10-12
- Wisdom of man could not reveal it. 1 Corinthians 1:18ff; cf. Jeremiah 10:23; Proverbs 14:12
- 1 Corinthians 2:7-13 "revealed through the Spirit ... that we might know ..."

What Paul Says About The SUBJECT Of His Preaching. Ephesians 3:8

Romans 16:25-27 "Now to him that is able to establish you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery which hath been <u>kept</u> <u>in silence through times eternal</u>, <u>but</u> <u>now is manifested</u>, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the eternal God, <u>is made known</u> unto all the nations unto obedience of faith: to the only wise God, through Jesus Christ, to whom be the glory for ever. Amen."

What Paul Says About The SUBJECT Of His Preaching. Ephesians 3:8

"<u>Riches</u> of Christ." Wealth, abundance. cf. Romans 5:20-21; Ephesians 1:7, 18; 2:7; 3:8, 16; cf. Colossians 1:27; 2:2

They are a fountain which, however many draw from its waters, never runs dry.

What Paul Says About The SUBJECT Of His Preaching. Ephesians 3:8

"<u>Riches</u> of Christ."

- ➢ Forgiveness. Life & death. Ephesians 2:1
- ▶ Reconciliation. Ephesians 2:16; Isaiah 59:1-2
- ▶ In The Body, the Church. cf. Ephesians 1:22-23
- The gospel. Ephesians 3:6; Romans 1:16; Hebrews 1:1
- Hope. Ephesians 4:4; 5:23
