



The Word Of God - Hebrews 4:12

"Is Living" (forever relevant) - Hebrews 3:7-8; 3:12-13; 4:7; cf. Psalms 95:7-11

- I Peter 1:23, "having been begotten again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, through the word of God, which liveth and abideth."
- It is God's vehicle of communication. Jeremiah 4:10; Luke 2:35; 1 Timothy 4:1; 2 Peter 1:20-21
 - Notice the comparable terminology used by Stephen in Acts 7:38 logia zonta "living oracles."

The Word Of God - Hebrews 4:12

"Is Active" (powerful) - cf. Psalms 95:7-11

"Referring to energy, i.e., engaged in work, capable of doing, active, powerful, effective (1 Corinthians 16:9; Philem. 6; Hebrews 4:12)." (The Complete Word Study Dictionary)

"... able to make things happen' Hebrews 4:12. (Greek-English Lexicon Based on Semantic Domain.)

- To create. Genesis 1; Hebrews 11:3; Psalms 33:6-9
- To sustain. Hebrews 1:3
- To prove. Hebrews 1:1-2; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Hebrews 2:1ff
- ∘ To save. Romans 1:16

The Word Of God - Hebrews 4:12

"Is Sharp, Piercing (cutting and penetrating) two-edged (distomos), two-mouthed, Rev 1:16 and 2:12: one like a son of man (1:13), from whose mouth a sharp two-edged sword comes forth; cf. 19:15" (Exegetical Dictionary of the New Testament.) cf. 2 Samuel 12:7; Acts 2:37; cf. Acts 7:54

1 Corinthians 4:5, "who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and make manifest the counsels of the hearts"

The Word Of God - Hebrews 4:12

"Discerning" (judging) "the thoughts and intents of the heart"

"Tracing out and passing judgment on the thoughts of the mind, Hebrews 4:12." (Thayer)

Matthew 15:18ff

Proverbs 4:23, "Keep thy heart with all diligence; For out of it are the issues of life." Proverbs 23:7, "For as he thinketh within himself, so is he"
