Cost of Unrighteousness

Peace of mind. (Good conscience) John 8:9: cf. Romans 7:7ff

- We can violate our conscience, which is sinful - Romans 14:22-23
- We can defile our conscience, leading to unbelief - Titus 1:15
- We can Sear our conscience, leading to apostasy - 1 Timothy 4:1-2; cf.
 Ephesians 4:17ff

Presence of God. (Conditional)
