Mark 2:3-5, "And they come, bringing unto him a man sick of the palsy, borne of four. And when they could not come nigh unto him for the crowd, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken it up, they let down the bed whereon the sick of the palsy lay. And Jesus seeing their faith saith unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins are forgiven."

What Jesus Saw In Four Men

Four men who cared. Mark 2:3

- They forgot self and helped the paralyzed man. cf. Matthew 16:24; Philippians 1:21; 1 John 3:17; 1 John 4:20–21
- God cared John 3:16, and cares. 1 Peter 5:6
- We must care. Luke 10:30ff; Acts 2,4,6,8 etc.; Hebrews 10:24

What Jesus Saw In Four Men

Four men who tried. Mark 2:4

- Went to work.
- Note: Four lepers. cf. 2 Kings 7:1-9
- Confidence in the power of God. TRY! cf. Romans 8:31; Philippians 4:13; Nehemiah 4:20, 6

What Jesus Saw In Four Men

Four men who worked together. Mark 2:4

- Amos 3:3 "Shall two walk together, except they have agreed?" cf. Nehemiah 5; Psalms 133:1; John 17:20-21; John 13:34
- Every one was necessary, no division.1 Corinthians 12:25-26; Nehemiah 3

What Jesus Saw In Four Men Four men who wanted to share Christ. Mark 2:4

- Andrew found Peter. John 1:40ff
- > Philip brought Nathanael. John 1:44ff
- Samaritan woman brought those of the city. John 4:28
- Scattered disciples preached the word. Acts 8:4
- Gospel spread throughout the world. Colossians 1:23
- Natural response. 2 Corinthians 4:7-13
- NOTE: These four men did not need healing, but they brought one who did need him. cf. Mark 2:17
