- No human requirements that must be met.

  - Who? Matthew 28:19; Mark 16:15-16; Acts 2:38; Acts 8:12
  - Why? "For remission of sins" Acts 2:38; Mark 16:15–16

#### Faith ... What Is Faith? Hebrews 11:1

#### Evidence

(elengchos) a proof of the things we cannot see or evidence that what we cannot see really exists Heb 11:1 (Greek-English Lexicon Based on Semantic Domain.)

- The evidence of the material world. Hebrews 11:3; Romans 1:20
- Psalms 19:1, "The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament showeth his handiwork."

### Faith That Jesus Is The Son Of God Is Based On Evidence

John 2:1-11 Changed water to wine. John 4:46-54 Healing of nobleman's son 20 miles away.

John 5 Healing of the afflicted man who had been infirm thirty-eight years.

John 6 Feeding of the five thousand.

John 6 Walking on the water.

John 9 Healing of the blind man.

John 11 Raising of Lazarus. cf. John 12:9–11

## Faith That Jesus Is The Son Of God Is Based On Evidence

John 12:37, "But though he had done so many signs before them, yet they believed not on him"

John 20:30-31, "Many other signs therefore did Jesus in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book: but these are written, that ye may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye may have life in his name."

### Repentance

Acts 17:30-31, "All men everywhere ..."
Romans 3:23, "for all have sinned ..."
Romans 4:15, "... where there is no law, neither is there transgression."

Therefore, <u>all</u> are under law!

### Repentance ... What Is Repentance?

- metanoia "a change of mind for the better, heartily to AMEND with abhorrence of one's past sins." (Thayer, 405)
- "This change of mind involves BOTH a turning from sin and a turning to God."
  (W.E. Vine, Volume 3, page 281)
- "John did not call on people to be sorry, but to change their mental attitudes AND CONDUCT." (A.T. Robertson, Word Pictures, Volume 1, page

### **Examples of Repentance**

- Jews on Pentecost. Acts 2
- Ninevites. Matthew 12:41; cf. Jonah 3:10
- Rebellious son. Matthew 21:28-29
- Prodigal son. Luke 15:11-21
- Thessalonians turned from idols. 1 Thessalonians 1:9
- Ephesians burned their books. Acts 19:19
- Jailor "washed their stripes."
- Acts 16:33
- Corinthians turned from former practices.
   1 Corinthians 6:9-11

These <u>all</u> brought forth fruit worthy of repentance! cf. Luke 3:8-14; Acts 26:19-20

# Confession ... What is confession? Made By ...

- God three times. Matthew 3:17; Matthew 17:5; John 12:28
- Made by the men of all ages.
  - Nathaniel (John 1:49); Peter (Matthew 16:16);
     Nicodemus (John 3:2); Thomas (John 20:28);
     Centurion (Matthew 27:54).
- Made of angels and demons. Luke 2:11; Mark 5:7
- Required by Jesus. Matthew 10:32-33
- Exemplified in Ethiopian eunuch. Acts 8:36-37.
