#### **Evil Influence Overcomes Good**

- "Looked back" refers to longing look desire
- Despite all of the evil seen in Sodom, it had become home and she wanted to return

- Rich ruler wanted salvation, but not enough

#### **FELIX: Fearful, But Delaying**

- Felix was moved by first hearing of gospel.
- But delay made his heart grow cold to truth.
- We do not have any assurance of tomorrow. (*James 4:13-17*)
- Procrastination before obeying shows that other things take priority. (*Luke 9:57-62*)
- If truth is rejected as people close their minds, it is not due to the Bible's lack of clarity. (*Acts* 28:23-28)

## Am I "Almost" or "Altogether" Persuaded To Obey Christ Now?

- Has a knowledge of truth moved me to obey, or do I remain unchanged as I reject gospel?
- Has my love for the sinful world caused me to come close to salvation, but look back?

  - Matthew 10:34-37 Serving the Lord may bring family trouble
- Following Christ will cost with hardships in life
  - Matthew 16:24-25 Deny self, take up cross and follow Christ
  - 2 Timothy 3:12 Christians will suffer persecution
  - Matthew 5:11-12 Disciples will be insulted and accused
  - Mark 13:13 Hated by all because of the name of Jesus

- Following Christ will cost our material things
  - Matthew 19:16-22 Rich young ruler told to sell all and follow
  - 1 Timothy 6:17-19 Giving in service lays up eternal
- Following Christ will cost time (*Ephesians 5:15-16*)
- Following Christ will cost whole self
  (Romans 12:1-2)


