



Revelation 21

"The 1901 American Standard Bible has as its subtitle for Revelation 21, 'The Consummation.' The idea of fulfillment and completion is depicted in the revelation of heaven's identity. The Apostle John sees far into the future. John sees a day when all humanity is raised, judged, and sent to their eternal abode. Satan and his demonic forces have been cast into hell. All that the saints had been promised and ever hoped for now comes to pass. At the point of the consummation the saints may finally have their promised rest (Heb. 4:1). The horrid battles against worldliness and false teaching will be over for ever. Satan's reign of terror ends. The saints shall now reign forever and eternally dwell in the presence of Jehovah God."

- Christians of all ages love to read about the **future abode** of the saints.
- How much would this be comforting to the **suffering saints** of the 1st century?
- Other **questions** have been answered:
 - Why is the tribulation taking place?
 - How long will it last?
 - What will be the final outcome?

THE NEW JERUSALEM

- A "new heaven and new earth"
 - This is not a **renovation** but a new order
 - Isaiah 34:3-5 End of the nations.
 - Isaiah 51:4 End of the Jewish order, Jerusalem.
 - Isaiah 51:16 Planting of a new heaven and earth.
 - Isaiah 65:16-17, 25 Fulfilled in the reign of Christ.
- "First heaven and first earth had passed away."
 - 2 Peter 3:7-13; Revelation 21 New order beyond the Judgment.
 - Different kind a complete transformation!
- This new heaven and earth will be clean and undefiled for the permanent dwelling place of those who have overcome the wiles of the devil during their lifetime.

THE NEW JERUSALEM

- "No more sea"
 - Sea of glass mentioned earlier separated God from His servants (4:6) is now removed.
 - The sea has been symbolic of the masses of humanity (Isaiah 57:20; 13:1; 20:13).
 - The masses have now been judged and are no
- Fellowship with God restored!
 - This new Jerusalem (church or assembly of saints judged righteous) is now presented to the Lord as a perfect bride with no blemishes of sin.
 (cf. Ephesians 5:25-27)

THE NEW JERUSALEM

- "John saw the holy city, New Jerusalem!"
 - God's people of all time periods, angels compromise this city
 - Hebrews 11:10, 13-16
- "Coming down out of heaven"
 - **Origin** of this city comes from God
 - Born from above John sees in a vision
- ullet "Prepared as a bride adorned for her husband "
- cf. Revelation 19:7-8
- Dressed in spotless white, purity
- Men and women have been transformed into a character of godliness, cleansed, and sanctified

TABERNACLE WITH GOD

- Uninterrupted **fellowship** and total union with God.
- The word **tabernacle** means "dwelling place."
- When the new Jerusalem appears, the Lord shall dwell with His people. They shall "see his face" (cf. Revelation 22:4; 1 John 3:2).
- For the first time in the history of mankind the saints shall see the Lord's face (cf. John 1:18).
- All distance between God and His people has been removed
- In the immediate presence of God
- Not just temporarily but forever
 - John 1:14

"and he shall wipe away every tear from their eyes; and death shall be no more; neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain, any more: the first things are passed away."

FORMER THINGS GONE

- Such a picture **overwhelms** the imagination
- Life in heaven has no inadequacies or unsatisfied needs of any sort
- **Death** is forever destroyed
- Sorrow gone replaced with joy
- Crying ceases no more oppression
- Pain/suffering ceases no more anguish
- "Former things" are passed away!
- The beauty of heaven is the absence of Satan. The horrors of hell is the absence of God.

ALL THINGS NEW


- "He that sitteth on the throne" has been identified as Jesus and/or God (cf. Revelation 3:21; 20:11).
- The new replaces the old. The old was subject to corruption, death, and sin.
- The new is immune from death, corruption, and sin because they have all been thrown into the lake of fire and are no longer a factor in the reigning bride of Christ (Revelation 20:13-15).

"And he said unto me, They are come to pass. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely."

RIVERS OF LIVING WATER

- As in the past (Isaiah 12:3; 55:1) and present (John 4:10ff; 7:37-38) rivers of living water represent the abundant salvation offered in the Lord.
- The new order, after the consummation, will also have rivers of living waters representing man's eternal salvation (see Revelation 22:1).
- All who, throughout their lives, hunger and thirst for righteousness will be filled (see Matthew 5:6).

DIVINE ASSURANCE

- "Overcometh" (nikao) (used seventeen times in Revelation) is "come off victorious: of Christians, that hold fast their faith even unto death against the power of their foes, and their temptations and persecutions" (Thayer, page 426).
 - NOTE: All the letters to the seven churches of Asia closed with special promises to the overcomers (2:7, 11, 17, 26; 3:5, 12, 21)
- God instructed John to write these things were true and dependable
- ullet "Alpha and Omega" "beginning and the end "
- He fulfills His promises


DIVINE ASSURANCE

- Salvation is a gift of God all who thirst can freely drink (22:17)
 - Forces none to drink
- The Faithful, those who overcome, will inherit theses things and God will be their Father!

DIVINE ASSURANCE

- The victorious saint shall inherit the new heavens, earth, and Jerusalem.
- Here is everlasting life (cf. Matthew 19:29; 25:34).
- True sons of God, the elect, those who loved not their lives unto death shall inherit God's eternal promised blessings (cf. Ephesians 1:13-14; Galatians 3:26).
- This is the message of the book of Revelation! Revelation 17:14, "These shall war against the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them, for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings; and they (also shall overcome) that are with him, called and chosen and faithful."
- Those who live faithfully until death will be crowned with eternal glory. (Revelation 2:10)

SECOND DEATH


- The "ungodly" have a very different fate
- Ungodly have no part in this "New Ierusalem"
 - Fearful (shrink back, unwilling to stand)
 - **Unbelieving** (refuse to accept Christ)
 - Abominable (vile, polluted hearts)
 - Murderers (willfully taking life)
 - Whoremongers (fornicators, sexual lust)
 - **Sorcerers** (witchcraft, magical arts)
 - **Idolaters** (worship of other gods not first)
 - Liars (deceive by tongue or actions)
 - Part in lake of fire and brimstone 2nd death!


"And there came one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls, who were laden with the seven last plagues; and he spake with me, saying, Come hither, I will show thee the bride, the wife of the Lamb."



Revelation 21 JOHN'S VISION

- One of the **seven angels**, which has seven vials of the last plagues, talked with John
- He is taken "in the Spirit" up to a high mountain
- From that **vantage point** he is allowed to **survey** the holy city
- He is going to see a detailed vision of the "Lamb's bride"
- It is a city descending from the **presence of God**
- This in its glorified and heavenly form





Revelation 21

DESCRIPTION OF THE CITY

- Having the "glory of God"
- Light was like was like a "jasper stone" (4:3)
- Clear as crystal
- Most scholars conclude this is like a **diamond**
- The beauty and grandeur of the city **reflect** the glory of God
- Brilliant light is pure and perfect (22:5)
