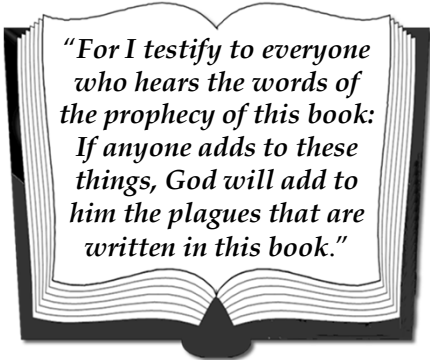

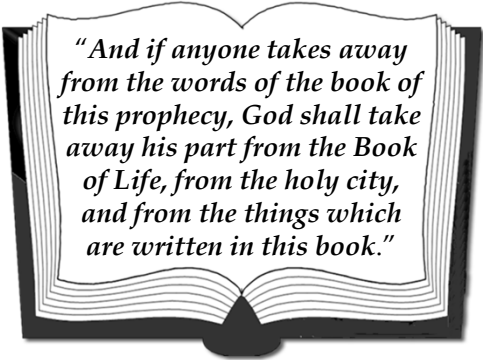

DIVINE WARNING

- The **admonition** here refers primarily to the teachings of **Revelation**
- Principle true in the **entire Bible** (Deuteronomy 4:2; Proverbs 30:6; Galatians 1:6-8)
- Solemn warning against “**tampering**” with God’s words!
- **Adding or subtracting** – serious consequences

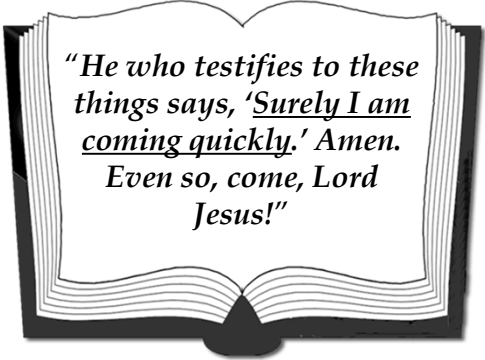

DIVINE WARNING

- Jehoiakim tried (**Jeremiah 36:23**)
- Jews tried (**James 2:10; Galatians 2:5**)
- Altering, amending, or changing any teaching in this book is **forbidden**
- God in His **infinite wisdom** knew what men would do with this book
- Sadly, the majority of the religious world has **failed to heed His warning!**



DIVINE WARNING

- To those who know not the Lord and have not obeyed the gospel, His coming will mean punishment (2 Thessalonians 1:7-9).
- To the righteous, His coming will bring comfort and peace (Philippians 1:21-23; 3:20-21; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17; 2 Timothy 4:6-8; 2 Peter 3:12-13).

CLOSING OF GOD’S REVELATION

- “The reoccurring theme of the book of Revelation is that those who overcome Satan’s onslaught of worldliness and false teaching shall be eternally exalted in glory. John’s final words in this book hammer the point home.
- John sees the glorious river of life and streets of gold (Revelation 22:1ff). The “blessed” will ever partake in this exalted and glorious place (Revelation 22:7, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14).
- The book ends with both a warning and an invitation to all. Let us all partake of the waters of eternal salvation for ever more!” (Notes from John Robertson)
