    - 1. Babylon is fallen, is fallen (verse 2)
    - 2. Babylon has become: (verse 2)
    - 3. The reason for her fall (verse 3)
  - B. *Another voice from heaven said:* (verses 4-8)
    - 1. "Come out" to God's people who dwell in her (verse 4)
    - 2. She will receive her just reward (verses 5-8)
