Get a letter – You have allowed the wicked to do their work!




A Church That Was Tolerant

Revelation 2:18-29

to Sardis.

- Longest and most difficult letter.
- Little known about the city from the text.
- text.

 Located on the road from Pergamum
- Originally established as a military outpost.
- Great trade center, wool, pottery, and expensive dyes.
- Lydia was from Thyatira (Acts 16:14).
- Known for trade guilds. (Note: banquets, cf. 1 Peter 4:1-5)



Thyatira was situated in a fertile valley through which trade routes passed. Although damaged by an earthquake during the reign of Augustus, Thyatira was rebuilt with Roman help.



Thyatira (modern Akhisar) has population of ~ 74,000

 - 2. The beauty of his stand

Revelation 2:18-29 II. The Strength (verse 19)

- A. Works Active, busy, doing, etc.
- B. Love For God, truth, others. Matthew 22:37-40
 - To love God means that one keeps His commandments. 1 John 5:3; John 14:15; 15:14
- C. Service Serving God and others (from love) 1 John 3:17-18; 4:20-21; Galatians 5:6; John 13:4-17
- D. Faith Belief, reaction to word, obedience Romans 10:17; James 2:14-24

II. The Strength (verse 19)

- E. Patience Perseverance, steadfast. Romans 5:3-5; James 1:2-4; Hebrews 10:35-39
- F. Last greater than first -
 - 1. Grown, progressed.
 - 2. Doing more now than had at first (often it is just the opposite).

"Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee ... " KJV

Revelation 2:18-29

Jezebel

Revelation 2:20, "... that thou sufferest the woman Jezebel"

- Wicked wife of wicked king Ahab (1 Kings 21:25)
- Daughter of Ethbaal, king of the Sidonians, and a worshipper of Baal.
- Supported 450 prophets of Baal. 1 Kings 18-19
- Eaten by dogs. 1 Kings 21:23; 2 Kings 9:10;
 2 Kings 9:33-35

Jezebel

Revelation 2:20, "... that thou sufferest the woman Jezebel"

- Here used symbolically like "Balaam" (2:14)
- May refer to a faction within the church
- May refer to a woman who had evil influence
- Claimed to be a prophetess but was not

III. The Weakness (verse 20)

Tolerant

- A. Jezebel was allowed (tolerated NASV)
 - 1. Not doing so themselves but tolerate it!
 - 2. Could have been stopped but nothing was done!
 - 3. Condemned for not taking action! 2 Thessalonians 3:6; 1 Corinthians 5

 - 1. Teach Christians to commit adultery
 - 2. Perhaps: by joining the trade guilds (with its sacrifices to idols) cf. 1 Corinthians 6, 8, and 10; Acts 15:20, 29
 - 3. No evidence that they "just quit"

Revelation 2:18-29

"The woman (or faction) referred to as Jezebel had not quit the church at Thyatira, and was not encouraging others to quit the church ... Many there are who would not think of quitting the church altogether, but who compromise with the devil on first one thing and then another."

III. The Weakness (verse 20) **Tolerant**

- A. Jezebel was allowed
- B. What was allowed
- C. The church bore some responsibility
 - God held the church responsible for its members. We need the constant presence of others who will "reprove, rebuke, and exhort" (2 Timothy 4:2).
 - 2. Blame is not just on Jezebel, but on the church! Philippians 2:15-16; 2 Corinthians 6:14-18; 3 John

IV. The Warning (verses 21-23)

Revelation 2:22-23, "Behold, I cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of her works. And I will kill her children with death; and all the churches shall know that I am he that searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto each one of you according to your works."

Revelation 2:18-29

IV. The Warning (verses 21-23)

- A. Rejected opportunities and refused to repent (verse 21)
- B. Faces judgment (verse 23); just and certain 2 Corinthians 5:10; Romans 2:6; 14:10-12
- C. Punishment (verses 22-23)
 - 1. Sickbed
 - 2. Tribulation
 - 3. Kill children with death
- D. The choice was theirs (verse 22) Galatians 6:7-8; Hebrews 13:4
