What Is The Point?

"He is invited by the first voice (1:10, the voice of Christ) to come to a place of advantage from which he will be able to see things from God's viewpoint. From John's point of view from Patmos there is a dark picture meeting the eye. But when he is able to see things from God's point of view, the coloring is changed radically. From that point of view he can see the eternal throne of God, which does not shake before the threats of Domitian and men of such character ...

What Is The Point?

... From the heavenly angle there is no doubt about the outcome of the struggle in which the Christians are engaged. Immediately the spiritual experience was intensified, and John saw the first guarantee of victory - God is on his throne. The Christians needed assurance; here it is: God has not abdicated in favor of Domitian or any other. In the very center of the vision is the sovereign God on his throne.'

He was "in the spirit" (1:10; 2 Corinthians 12:2-4)


Saw a throne set in heaven.

It is the seat of sovereignty, the symbol of regal authority, from which justice and judgment are dispensed. (Psalms 89:14)

The throne was not there for this vision only, it was set, established as the throne of heaven. (Psalms 119:89)

Saw one "sitting" on that throne

<u>Jasper</u> was an opaque species of different colors, subject to high polish. The New Testament use of the term "jasper," here and elsewhere referred to a transparent gem, the diamond, or the translucent chalcedon.

<u>Sardius</u> was an ancient favorite of the engraver's art, discovered in Asia Minor, of lasting beauty of color; it was a brilliant flesh red.

Revelation 4 and 5



"A rainbow round about the throne" – 4:3. The rainbow stands for a covenant (Genesis 9:13-17) and the emblem here is of the covenanted protection from the judgment of impending events; not escape from the suffering, but exemption from judgments, which would come upon the enemies of the church.

Revelation 4 and 5



"In sight like an emerald" - 4:3.

The rainbow is a seven-color reflection. Its brilliance appears between the shining sun and the rain clouds. Here *emerald* in the bow is specified – a very precious gem, of deep green color – which is its real value, as the deepest colors were the prized. The word *emerald* had a root meaning of glowing.

"And round about the throne (were) four and twenty thrones: and upon the thrones (I saw) four and twenty elders sitting, arrayed in white garments; and on their heads crowns of gold."

24 Thrones - 24 Elders

24 Thrones – 24 Elders = "organized religion" (12)

- God's "<u>redeemed</u>" on both sides of the cross?
 (21:12-14) Not until the final consummation ...
- Around the throne
- Clothed in white garments
- Golden crowns (stephanos = victory)



- Offer continual worship 4:10-11






Powerful Throne

- Powerful decrees from the throne
- Lightnings, thunderings, and voices. cf. Exodus 19:16
- "Seven lamps" of fire burning (light)
- "Seven Spirits" of God = Holy Spirit (cf. 1:4)
 - Since the work of the Holy Spirit is that of illumination of the truth (John 16:13), lamps of fire burning offer a graphic portrayal of this mission.
- The glory, majesty, splendor, and brilliance of God's rule
- To be sure God is in control and on the throne!



Sea of Glass

- Would seem to separate the 24 elders from the throne of God
- The "best glass" would be like crystal, with normal glass being dark, dull, or even opaque.
- That which is precious also separates those who are able to approach the throne from God Himself.
- Later John relates that there is "no more
- sea" (21:1).
 - "Perhaps the difference is that what John sees now are events that occur before the final judgment, but after 20:11-15 he describes a heavenly scene wherein God will dwell with all saints (21:3)." (Harkrider)



Revelation 4 and 5

Four Living Creatures

- "Full of eyes" all-seeing ability
- "Cherubim" (Ezekiel 10:5, 10, 18, 20)"Seraphim" (Isaiah 6:1-2)
- "Lion" strength
- "Calf" service
- "Man" intelligence
- "Flying Eagle" velocity and swiftness
- These living creatures are special servants of God strong, swift, intelligent, and always vigilant. Beings of the highest order that guard holy things of God and never fail to worship.
