Evidence – Appearances

The tomb was found empty. Luke 24:1-8, "Why seek ye the living among the dead? He is not here, but is risen."

- 1. Mary Magdalene. Mark 16:9-11; John 20:11-18
- 2. The women. Matthew 28:9-10; Luke 24:9-11
- **3. Peter**. Luke 24:34; 1 Corinthians 15:5
- 4. The two disciples on their way to Emmaus. Mark 16:12-13; Luke 24:13-15
- The eleven (minus one). Mark 16:14; Luke 24:36-43; John 20:19-25
- 6. To the disciples, including Thomas. John 20:24-28; 1 Corinthians 15:5
- 7. The seven disciples at the Sea of Galilee. John 21:1-25

Evidence – Appearances

The tomb was found empty. Luke 24:1-8, "Why seek ye the living among the dead? He is not here, but is risen."

- The eleven disciples on the mountain in Galilee. Matthew 28:16-20; Mark 16:15-16; Luke 24:46-47
 - Over 500 at once. 1 Corinthians 15:6

Jesus' Ninth Appearance

James. 1 Corinthians 15:7

- Whether in Galilee or Jerusalem is uncertain.
- During His ministry, Jesus' brothers did not believe in Him (John 7:5); indeed, they considered Him to be insane (Mark 3:20-21).
- Jesus' resurrection appearance to James is the best explanation of the change from unbelief to belief.

Jesus' Tenth Appearance and Ascension. Mark 16:19-20; Luke 24:44-53; Acts 1:3-12; 1 Corinthians 15:7

All the apostles on the Mount of Olives.

- Jesus showed Himself alive for 40 days. Acts 1:3
- All things must be fulfilled. Luke 24:48
- Apostles to go to the city (Jerusalem) and wait. Luke 24:49
- Wait for the promise of the Father. Acts 1:4, 8

Jesus' Tenth Appearance and Ascension. Mark 16:19-20; Luke 24:44-53; Acts 1:3-12; 1 Corinthians 15:7

All the apostles on the Mount of Olives.

- A proof of His Messiahship. John 6:62
- Enabled the sending of the Holy Spirit. John 16:5-7
- Established Jesus as **King** over His Kingdom. Mark 16:19.
 - "*Right hand of God*" Position of favor, trust, and power. Acts 2:33ff; Psalms 110:1
- Daniel 7:13-14 Daniel's vision prophesied this event.
- cf. Ephesians 1:20-23
