







### Triumphant Entry Into Jerusalem Sunday

#### **Preparation:**

- Secures the colt. Matthew 21:1-7; cf. Mark 11:2; Luke 19:30
- Fulfilled two Old Testament prophecies.

Isaiah 62:11, "Behold, Jehovah hath proclaimed unto the end of the earth, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, **Behold**, **thy salvation cometh**; behold, his reward is with him, and his recompense before him."

Zechariah 9:9, "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: **behold, thy king cometh unto thee**; he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and **riding upon an ass, even upon a colt the foal of an ass.**"

### The Procession Into The City.

- Multitude met him with palm branches. John 12:12-13
- Multitude spread their garments on the road. Matthew 21:8

# Triumphant Entry Into Jerusalem Sunday

### Shouts Of The People As Jesus Entered.

- Matthew 21:8-9, "And the most part of the multitude spread their garments in the way; and others cut branches from the trees, and spread them in the way. And the multitudes that went before him, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the son of David: Blessed (is) he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest."
- Mark 11:9-10, "And they that went before, and they that followed, cried, Hosanna; Blessed (is) he that cometh in the name of the Lord: <u>Blessed (is) the kingdom that cometh, (the kingdom) of our father David</u>: Hosanna in the highest."

## Triumphant Entry Into Jerusalem Sunday

#### Shouts Of The People As Jesus Entered.

- Luke 19:37–38, "the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works which they had seen; saying, Blessed (is) the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest."
- John 12:13, "took the branches of the palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried out, Hosanna: Blessed (is) he that cometh in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel."
- Hosanna in Hebrew means "save we pray." cf. Psalms 118:25

Triumphant Entry Into Jerusalem Sunday

#### Shouts Of The People As Jesus Entered Reflect Misunderstanding Of The Nature Of The Kingdom.

- Earlier some had tried to force Jesus to become a king, but He refused. John 6:15
- My kingdom is not of this world.
  - To the Pharisees. Luke 17:20-21
- To Pilate. John 18:36
- Paul made it clear that the kingdom was spiritual, not physical. Romans 14:17; 1 Corinthians 15:50
