*Luke 22:19-20; cf. 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

Thursday – The Passover Meal

"Last Supper" cf. Luke 22:14-18

- This would be the last time Jesus would **physically** eat the Passover with His disciples while He was on earth.
- The next time would be **spiritually**. It would involve His presence with disciples in commemorating His death **in His kingdom**. (cf. Mark 9:1; Acts 1:3)

Thursday – The Passover Meal

Judas' Betrayal Foretold – Matthew 26:21-25;
Mark 14:18-21; *Luke 22:21-23; John 13:21-35

- One of you will betray me. Matthew 26:20-21
- Jesus foretold that the one who dipped the bread with Him would betray Him. Matthew 26:22-23; see Psalms 41:9

➤ Would be good for that man if he had not been born.
Matthew 26:24

- Matthew 26:25, *"And Judas, who betrayed him, answered and said, Is it I, Rabbi? He saith unto him, Thou hast said."*

Thursday – The Passover Meal

Peter's Denial Foretold. Matthew 26:31-35;

Mark 14:27-31; *Luke 22:31-38; John 13:36-38

1. He would be tempted.

Overconfident:

- Matthew 26:33, *"If all shall be offended in thee, I will never be offended."*
- Luke 22:33, *"And he said unto him, Lord, with thee I am ready to go both to prison and to death."*
- Jesus prayed for him.

2. He would yield to the temptation before morning.

3. He would be restored.

Thursday – The Passover Meal

The Institution of the Lord's Supper.

Matthew 26:26-29; Mark 14:22-25; *Luke 22:19-20;
cf. 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

"This do in remembrance of me."

- Remember His death. Matthew 26:28
- Remember His love. Romans 5:8
- Remember the horror of sin. Romans 6:23; Hebrews 9:22; 10:1ff
 - Makes the new covenant possible. Hebrews 9:16
 - Makes remission possible. Ephesians 1:7
