Defining Evil

I Thessalonians 5:22

• poneros: hurtful, wicked

- kakos: worthless, depraved
- sapros: rotten, corrupt
- Real Matthew 5:43-48
- Comes from the heart Mark 7:21-23;
 Matthew 9:2-4; 12:33-37
- Against God's Will John 5:25-29

Evil Calls Evil "Good" Evil Calls Good "Evil"

- Woe to those who do so Isaiah 5:20-21
- Sin of every sort (godlessness)
 - Moral corruption
 - Relativism versus absolute truth,
 - Sexual perversions
 - Religious apostasy

The Progression That Leads To Calling Evil Good And Good Evil

(cf. James 1:14-15)

3

- First we overlook evil (cf. Proverbs 19:11; Matthew 21:12-13; Ephesians 6:10-13)
- Then we permit evil (cf. Malachi 1:6-14; Matthew 27:24)
- Then we legalize evil
- Then we promote evil
- Then we celebrate evil
- Then we persecute those who still call it evil

The Progression That Leads To Calling Evil Good And Good Evil

Overlook Evil

- · Begin to tolerate evil
 - "Everybody does it."
 - "Nobody is harmed."
 - "It's a personal choice and none of your business."
- Jesus does not tolerate evil Matthew 21:12-13 – "drove out all"
- We must not Ephesians 6:10-13; 5:15-16)

Permit Evil

- Parents, schools, governments, churches
- Pilate John 19:10; Matthew 27:24
- We must not I Thessalonians 5:22 I Corinthians 5:13

The Progression That Leads To Calling Evil Good And Good Evil

Legitimize (legalize) Evil

- Satan's tactic (flesh, eyes, pride) Genesis 3:4-6 (I John 2:16)
- "The end justifies the means," (theft, abortion, gambling, pornography, etc.) - Romans 3:8
- We must not Ephesians 4:27

The Progression That Leads To Calling Evil Good And Good Evil

Promote Evil

(II Chronicles 19:2)

- Religious promotion Matthew 23:14-15
 - Denominations "blessing" samesex marriages
- We must abstain from, not promóte -1 Thessalonians 5:22; Ephesians 5:11

The Progression That Leads To Calling Evil Good And Good Evil

Celebrate Evil

- Satanic Temple altar, Pride month, hate groups
- Judah and Jerusalem Jeremiah 32:31-35 – "provoke me to anger"
- We must celebrate righteousness Ephesians 4:20-24 - "in true righteousness and holiness",

Persecute Those Who Still Call It Evil

- "Judgmental, hateful, intolerant, bigot, self-righteous"
- "Cancel Culture" tries to silence those with whom they do not agree
- Follow the apostles' examples I Corinthians 4:9-13; Il Corinthians 4:7 6:3-10

What We Do When Evil is Called Good and Good Evil

Do not render evil for evil -

Romans 12:17-21 – "do what is honorable"

- I Peter 3:13-17:
 - God's blessing is on you
 - Always be prepared to give answers
 - Maintain good conduct
 - Suffer for doing good
- Be salt and light, Matthew 5:13-16; Ephesians 5:8

"What Must I Do To Be Saved?"

► Hear the Word of God

Acts 16:3

- ► Romans 10:8 "But what does it say? 'The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart' (that is, the word of faith that we proclaim)"
- ▶ Believe that Jesus is the Savior
 - ► Romans 10:11 "For the Scripture says, 'Everyone who believes in will not be put to shame."

"What Must I Do To Be Saved?"

Acts 16:30

- ► Repent of your sins
 - ► Acts 3:19 "Repent therefore, and turn again, that your sins may be blotted out"
- ► Confess that Jesus is the Son of God
 - ▶ I John 4:15 "Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God."

"What Must I Do To Be Saved?"

- ► Be immersed in water for forgiveness Acts 16:30
 - ► Acts 2:38 "And Peter said to them, 'Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."
- ► Remain faithful
 - ► Hebrews 3:14 "For we share in // Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end."
