**They Were Not Ashamed, Neither Could They Blush**

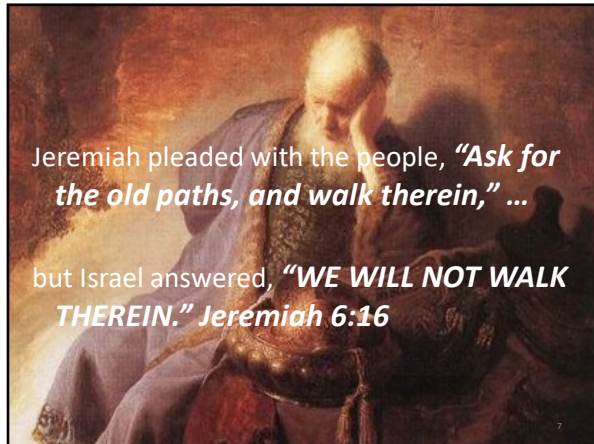
*"Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? nay, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush." Jeremiah 6:15*
