- We Are Witnesses to His Faithfulness
 His goodness should convince us that He is worthy of our trust and commitment
 - I Timothy 6:17-19 "God, who richly provides us"
- Israel should have observed his history with God and trusted Him with his life
 - Isaiah 1:2-4 "they are utterly estranged"
 - Isaiah 30:1-3 "Ah, stubborn children"
 - Isaiah 31:1 "Woe to those who go down to Egypt for help

The Purpose Of God's Goodness

Leads Us Away from Sin to Him

- Paul's conclusion at Athens was the demand for repentance
 - Acts 17:30-31 "now he commands all people everywhere to repent"
- God's goodness to the Jews was to lead them to repentance
 - Romans 2:1-4 "lead you to repentance"
 - cf. Ezekiel 18:31 "a new heart"
- This change of will is meant to change action from doing evil to doing good
 - Romans 1:8-10 "your faith is proclaimed"

The Purpose Of God's Goodness

Leads Us to Faithfulness

- God's goodness continues to those who continue in it
 - Romans 11:19-23 "provided you continue in his kindness"
- His grace teaches us to remain faithful to Him with anticipation of further goodness from Him
 - Titus 2:11-14 "waiting for our blessed hope"
 - Titus 3:4-8 "heirs according to the hope"
- He nourishes His people because He wants them to trust Him and remain faithful
 - Isaiah 1:2-3, 16-20 "If you are willing"

 James 1:21 - "Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls."

Believe the Gospel message

 Hebrews 11:6 - "And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him."

Taking The Right Path

Repent of your sins

 Acts 3:19 - "Repent therefore, and turn again, that your sins may be blotted out"

Confess that Jesus is the Son of God

• Romans 10:9-10 - "... because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved."

Taking The Right Path

Be immersed in water

 Acts 2:38 - "And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

Remain faithful

 Hebrews 3:12-14 - "... if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end"
