I Corinthians 10:1-13

**“THEY DRANK OF A SPIRITUAL ROCK”**

- ✘ Spiritual food and spiritual drink
  - + John 4:14 - “the water that I shall give him”
  - + John 4:32, 34 - “I have meat to eat that ye know not”
  - + Matthew 23:23-27 - “these ye ought to have done”
- ✘ “The rock was Christ”

**“THEY DRANK OF A SPIRITUAL ROCK”**

- ✘ We also have this spiritual food
  - + John 6:26-28 - “Work not for the food that perisheth”
  - + John 6:35 - “I am the bread of life”

**“WE SHOULD NOT LUST AFTER EVIL THINGS”**

- ✘ How quickly the Israelites turned away
  - + Exodus 32:1 - “Up, make us gods”
- ✘ We also turn away
  - + Galatians 1:6-9 - “ye are so quickly removing

**“WE SHOULD NOT LUST AFTER EVIL THINGS”**

- ✘ Our “lust” must be for good things
  - + Matthew 13:16-17 - “desired (lusted) to see the things which ye see”

**“NEITHER BE YE IDOLATERS”**

- ✘ The people of Israel immediately wanted other gods
  - + Exodus 32:3-9 - “they have turned aside quickly”
- ✘ The people continued to seek other gods

**“NEITHER BE YE IDOLATERS”**

- ✘ We let “idolatry” interfere
  - + Colossians 3:5-6 – “... covetousness, which is idolatry”
  - + Ephesians 5:5 – “... covetous man, who is an idolater”
  - + James 4:1-3 – “spend it in your pleasures”

**“NEITHER BE YE IDOLATERS”**

- ✘ Paul shows by example the proper attitude
  - + Acts 20:33-35 – “I coveted no man’s silver, or gold, or apparel.”

**“NEITHER LET US COMMIT FORNICATION”**

- ✘ Numbers 25:1-8 – “the people began to play the harlot”
- ✘ The Corinthian Christians are living in a city where such activity is common
- ✘ The church got caught up in it
  - + I Corinthians 5:1 – “fornication among you”

**“NEITHER LET US COMMIT FORNICATION”**

- ✘ We are all admonished
  - + I Corinthians 6:13b-20 – “the body is not for fornication, but for the Lord”

**“NEITHER LET US MAKE TRIAL OF THE LORD”**

- ✘ Numbers 21:4-9 – “the people spake against God”
- ✘ John encourages us
  - + Revelation 3:10 – “keep thee from the hour of trial”

**“NEITHER MURMUR YE”**

- ✘ The people of Israel were big on murmuring
  - + Exodus 15:22-24 – “murmured against Moses”
  - + Exodus 16:2, 7 – “murmurings against Jehovah”
  - + Numbers 14:26-32 – “murmur against me”

## **“NEITHER MURMUR YE”**

- × Paul admonishes us
  - + Philippians 2:14-16 – “Do all things without murmurings and questionings”

## **“THAT YE MAY BE ABLE TO ENDURE”**

- × Once again we are admonished
  - + II Timothy 4:1-4 – “For the time will come when they will not endure the sound doctrine”
- × We must press on
  - + II Timothy 2:8-13 – “I endure all things for the elect’s sake ... if we endure, we shall also reign with him”

## **“WRITTEN FOR OUR ADMONITION”**

- × The people of whom we’ve read are “witnesses”
  - + See all of Hebrews 11
  - + Hebrews 12:1 – “run with patience”
- × I Peter 1:9-12 – “unto you, did they minister these things”

## **“WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?”**

ACTS 16:30

- × Hear the Word of God
  - + Romans 10:8 – “the word of faith”
- × Believe in that Word
  - + Romans 10:11 – “Whosoever believeth on him”
- × Repent of your sins
  - + Acts 3:19 – “Repent ye therefore, and turn again”
- × Confess that Jesus is the Son of God
  - + I John 4:15 – “confess that Jesus is the Son of God”
- × Be immersed in water (baptized)
  - + Acts 2:38 – “unto the remission of your sins”
